- ☐ Water Bottle, Refillable, Plastic or Metal with Straw and Sealable Lid
- ☐ Locker Shelves, Metal, to fit Lockers 12"x12"x60
- ☐ Pencil Case, or Pencil Bag
- ☐ Pencils with Erasers, Mechanical or Wooden - *students may use mechanical pencils, but these may be confiscated if used inappropriately*
- ☐ Colored Pencils, 12 count pkg.
- ☐ Blue or Black Ball-Point Pens
- ☐ Red Ball-Point Pens
- ☐ 1 Ruler, 12", *Metric & English*, 1/16" Scale
- ☐ 1 College Ruled Composition Book, 70 sheets minimum

General Guidelines

- Binders, notebooks, and folders should be a **solid color** and the **same color** for a given class. No logos, designs, or pop culture characters.
- Folders should have **2 pockets and be 3-hole punched** to fit inside binders.
- Please label **all school supplies** (notebooks, binders, folders, etc.) as well as **fleece, sweaters, outerwear, water bottles, and lunch boxes** with your child's full name.

- ☐ 6 Boxes Facial Tissues - *minimum*
- ☐ 2 Erasers for Dry Erase Whiteboard
- ☐ 4 Canisters or pkgs. of Sanitizing Hand Wipes OR 4 Containers Hand Sanitizer with Pump, Household Size
- ☐ 4 Canisters Clorox Wipes
- ☐ 1 Box Nitrile Gloves
